## NATIONAL JUNIOR SHOW OFFICIAL RULES

The youth activities at the National show are lots of fun and we hope all of you, whether you are showing an animal or just coming to have fun, participate in all the activities! All activities do require you to be an active Jr. Member to participate. Junior Members will be able to show an animal in BOTH the National Jr. Show and the National Show. This enables the Jr. Members to compete against the Jr. Members in the Jr. National Show, and adults in the National Show.

**Eligibility:** Only animals registered with the International Boer Goat Association, Inc. may be shown at the National Junior Show. Exhibitor **MUST** be a Junior member in good standing to show their animal. All animals must be submitted for registration by June 8, 2009, to be shown at the National Jr. Show. Goats must be registered in the name of the Jr. Member. An original certificate will be required on all animals to be presented at the time of check-in. No copies of registration or stamped duplicates shall be accepted. All animals must be in place and checked in by 6:00 p.m., Tuesday, July 7, 2009.

**Entries:** There is no limit to the number of goats a Jr. Member may enter in any class. If a Jr. Member has more than one animal entered in a class they may have another Jr. Member assist them in showing that animal. Unfortunately, if the Junior Member is unable to attend due to illness or other unforeseen circumstance, the animal **CANNOT** be shown by another Junior Member. All applications for entry must be submitted on current official entry forms in accordance with instructions on same, giving all necessary information requested. The entry fee per animal will be \$25.00/each. The deadline by which entries should be postmarked to avoid a late fee is June 15, 2009. A late fee will be imposed and \$50.00 will be charged for all entries postmarked or received after June 16<sup>th</sup> through June 22, 2009. No entries will be accepted after June 22<sup>nd</sup>.

The classes and all other general Rules and Guidelines of the International Boer Goat Assn. U.S. National Show will apply. If you should have any questions in reference to the activities at the Nationals, please call the office staff at International, 877-402-4242.

**T-SHIRT DESIGN COMPETITION:** Are you the creative type? Have you ever thought about being a famous designer? Well, if you are between the ages of 8 through 19, here is your chance. We are asking all our junior members to test their creativity and design our 2009 Junior International Official Show Shirt. We would like you to develop a T-shirt that using something more than the traditional emblem. We ask the t-shirt has a Boer Goat theme. The design should have no more than 3 colors that can be used on a bright yellow t-shirt as the background. The design could be marker or crayon and should not be larger than 8 ½ X 11. The designer should attach the official T-shirt form to the back of their design before submitting it to the office for judging. The design would be on the back of shirt with the designing youth's signature and 2009 International Junior Nationals on pocket. The top "T" Shirt design will receive a \$100.00 framed Savings Bond and be recognized at the Nationals. Profits go to Youth Fund. Deadline for entries are June 8, 2009.

**SILENT AUCTION:** We had great success with the **Silent Auction** last year and will again have some great items this year. We are asking that each youth member brings at least one item for the auction. You will earn 10 junior points towards Premier Exhibitor. All proceeds will go to the Youth Fund in hopes that we can have more regional Jr. Shows and field days to help promote the International Boer Goat Association youth. Everyone, young and old is invited to participate in this event. If you have an item that you would like to donate, please contact Alice Thompson or the International Office, or you can just bring it to the show. Items can be turned in at check in. Profits go to the Youth Fund.

**OFFICER ELECTIONS:** This will be our first time for electing Junior Officers. Openings are for President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, Reporter, and Vice-Reporter. Officers will be voted for at the Pizza Party during the National Show. Elected Officials will be announced during the opening ceremonies of the Junior National Show. **CONTEST AWARDS:** We will be awarding Boer Bucks to our first and second place winners in each class and first and second place winners in each youth activity. First place winners will receive \$50.00 in Boer Bucks and Second place winners will be receiving \$25.00 in Boer Bucks. These Bucks may be redeemed at full face value with any of the vendors at the show or can be traded in for half face value by the end of the National Show. **At the close of the National Show, Boer Bucks will have NO money value.**

**PREMIER EXHIBITORS:** This year we will be honoring our first ever Junior Premier Exhibitors. This honor will be awarded to the junior member in each age division with the most accumulated points for participation in all the National Show junior activities. These points will be totaled at the completion of Thursday's show events. **The Junior Premier Exhibitor from each class with the most points accumulated from all youth activities will win a show goat or the Dam of a show goat.** This makes it very important to participate in all activities. If a child has more than one goat in a class, points will go towards the highest placing goat in that class for that junior exhibitor.

\*In the event of a tie, the top two finalists will be brought to the show ring where they will be given random questions on Boer goat breed standards. The first junior to answer five questions correctly will be awarded Junior Premier Exhibitor.

## Junior Show Activities for the Youth

This year we will have many activities for our juniors. We have made a few changes to our program to encourage additional participation from all youth. Youth activities will be divided into the following classes.

**\*Peewee (5 years and under)**

**\*Junior (9-11 years of age)**

**\*Senior (16 to under 19 years of age)**

**\*Yearly (6-8 years of age)**

**\*Intermediate (12-15 years of age)**

There will be a \$5.00 entry fee for each youth activity. All activities require Pre-registration on the attached Youth Entry form. **(Late entry will be \$10.00)**

**SHOWMANSHIP:** Showmanship is one of our most valued competitions. It is always amazing to watch our youth with their animals. **The goats used for Youth Showmanship must also be entered in the National Show and pre-registration on the enclosed Youth Entry form is required.**

**10th ANNUAL STICK GOAT CONTEST:** On your mark, get set.... **Go!** We are really looking forward to the Tenth Annual Stick Goat Contest and Race. This event has been a great hit and we are looking forward to seeing what these creative kids come up with this year! Competitors in this event create their version of a Boer Goat Head - on a stick! The goat will be judged on creativeness and resemblance of a Boer Goat. Ribbons are awarded to all participants. The Stick Goat competitors will then take their entries on a wild ride around the show ring to see who can make it to the finish line the fastest. We will have our Annual Stick Goat Auction kick off the dinner on Friday night. Please, show your support to our youth participants for their creative efforts and "stick" around to bid. All proceeds will directly benefit the Youth Fund! Let's make 2009 the best year ever!

**YOUTH GOAT SCRAMBLE:** The Association is proud to continue the tradition of the Annual Youth Goat Scramble; it has been successful in the past and should continue to be successful. Those in the Peewee and Yearly classes will be challenged to grab pom-poms off of the back of the goats in the ring. The Jr. Members in the Junior, Intermediate, and Senior divisions will need to catch a goat and bring it to the judge on a lead.

**EDUCATIONAL DISPLAY CONTEST:** The **Educational Display Contest** offers an opportunity for Jr. Members to increase their communication skills during the creative display of a message or education of the Boer Goat Industry through an educational display. All display **MUST** be submitted for display and judging by 9:00 PM on Tuesday, July 7, 2009.

**PHOTO CONTEST:** The **Photo Contest** encourages Jr. Members to share their experiences through the display of their favorite pictures. This year there will only be two categories for photo entries; "Boer Goats" and "Around the Farm". Pictures should be no larger than an 8X10 size. All display **MUST** be submitted for display and judging by 9:00 PM on Tuesday, July 7, 2009.

**GOAT JUDGING CONTEST:** The **Goat Judging Contest** encourages Jr. Members to enhance their judging skills through the judging of various classes of goats. Members will be required to place goats according to International Boer Goat Standards.

**COSTUME PARADE/CONTEST:** It's Halloween in July! This contest allows members to show their love for their goats. Members dress up themselves and their goats to fit their personality. We have seen all kinds, including ELVIS!

**SCAVENGER HUNT:** We found this event to be so successful last year! It was amazing how everyone got together, the youth and adults alike, to help the kids win. The youth will break into small groups, the younger kids will be mixed with the older kids. Each team is given a list of items to find such as: business cards, names of animal/owner that won in the National Show, name of sponsors, etc. plus things like a blue shoe string, pink lipstick, a napkin, or a signature from someone important. So you will need to pay attention to the happenings of the show! This is a great way increase lines of communication between our Junior and Adult Members.

**BOOT SCRAMBLE:** JUST FOR FUN! We hope you have some Ropers. Not the lace up kind! This contest is fun for all, especially the spectators. Members will take off their boots and form a pile in the center of the arena. They will then line up. On the word "GO", Members have to run to the pile, find their boots, and make it back to the finish line as fast as they can!
