Please read General Rules and Regulations carefully

1. All entries must be registered with a recognized Boer Goat Breed Registry-- INTERNATIONAL BOER GOAT ASSOCIATION, ABGA, USBGA, or CANADIAN BOER GOAT ASSOCIATION. Only animals registered with International Boer Goat Association will receive official show points.
2. An original certificate of registration or an "official copy", a copy originating from the International Boer Goat Association, Inc. office by fax or email, is required for all animals six (6) months or older.
An original certificate, official copy, or a faxed or stamped duplicate of application made to IBGA office will work for any animal under six (6) months of age.
3. All goats must have legible tattoos that match the registration papers
4. Birth dates, as listed on the registration certificate, will be used to determine the class divisions. Show date will be the base date for computing ages for classes. Classes for Percentage Does (50%-88%), Full Blood/American Purebred Does and Full Blood/American Purebred Bucks.
5. There is no limit to the number of entries an exhibitor may enter in a class.
6. ALL IBGA SANCTIONED SHOW RULES APPLY. Please be familiar with these.
7. Any animal that is 24 months of age or older shall compete as a senior. A buck must have offspring resulting from live coverage; a doe must be visibly pregnant or have kidded by 24 months of age. Any animals that do not meet these requirements are not eligible to show.
8. An exhibitor shall not present an animal to be shown under a judge from whom it was purchased or possession taken within 6 months of the show. Any judge being co-owner with another member/owner/exhibitor shall not be allowed to judge that member's animals for a period of six (6) months after dissolving ownership. Should this happen, all points awarded by that judge will be forfeited.
9. Any goat showing a pronounced defect, sickness, or abnormality will not be permitted to show. Out of State entries must present a health certificate on each animal current within 30 days. Health Certificates will be checked upon unloading animals.
10. Pens will be assigned based on the order entries are received. Show management reserves the right to limit pen space. No tack pens will be available. Ample tack space and grooming space is available outside of penning area.
11. Grooming will not take place in the penning area. There will be a heated wash area with grooming area adjacent. All wash bays have hot and cold water.
12. Hay is allowed to be fed in the barn. No Straw is allowed in the barn.
13. Show Barn will be open Thursday afternoon for early arrivals. Show Barn will open on Friday morning, May 28th at 7:00 a.m. CST. Registration for ALL Weekend activities will begin at 12:00 Noon CST. **Murray, KY is on Central Time!** (Special Arrangements Needed? Call 270-832-1167).
14. Show officials reserve the right to remove any person or persons from the show, facilities and grounds who demonstrate unsportsmanlike or inappropriate behavior either inside or outside of the show ring.
15. **Non-Traditional Show Rules:**
Animals shown in the Non-Traditional Show must have Non-Traditional registration papers unless registered before April 1, 2010. In order to be registered in the Non-Traditional herd book an

animal must have at least 15% body coloring not counting the head and ears. Animals that are shown in the Non-Traditional Show can NOT show in an open show if the two shows are held on the same day or with the same judge.

16. Junior Show Rules:

All exhibitors participating in a junior show must be under 19 years of age on January 1, of the current year. Any animal shown in a Junior show must be registered in the youth's name. Animals that are shown in the Junior Show can NOT show in an open show if the two shows are held on the same day or with the same judge.

17. Although every precaution will be taken to protect the safety and comfort of the exhibitors, neither Boers & Bluegrass Enterprises, Show Management, Murray State University, State of Kentucky or the International Boer Goat Association assumes any responsibility in this matter and disclaims any liability, legal or otherwise, in case of accidents or loss of property.

18. Entry Fees:

- a. Boers & Bluegrass Non-Traditional Show - \$10 per head
- b. Open - Boers & Bluegrass Spring Edition #1 - \$10 per head
- c. Market Show - \$15 per head
- d. Eastern Regional International Sanctioned Junior Show - \$10 per head
- e. Eastern Regional International Sanctioned Open Show - \$15 per head
- f. Open – Boers & Bluegrass Spring Edition #2 - \$10 per head

Entry Discounts: Junior – Animal Entered in One Show per day (3 shows) = \$25 per animal (\$5 discount)

Entry Discounts: Open – Animal Entered in One Show per day (2 shows) = \$30 per animal (\$5 discount)

19. Pen Fees: (No showing off trailer – All animals will be penned) Pens are 5 X 5 and 48” tall (most will have 4X4 welded goat wire – can clip feeders & buckets) All Pens are \$15 each for entire weekend. Please plan to pen as many animals as are practical in each pen. Please understand that destructive or unruly animals may be removed from the barn into more rugged pens if necessary. (We have new pens)

20. All entries are due (postmarked) by MAY 15, 2010 to receive regular price and discounts. Add \$2.00 per head for “Onsite Registration” (Exception – youth showing market entries only may “Onsite Register” at Weigh-in)

RULES OF THE SHOW

1. All goats will bear an official Scrapie ID Tag.
2. Show is open to does and wethers.
3. Goats must have a full set of kid's teeth.
4. Unethical feeding and/or fitting practices are strictly forbidden by the Boers & Bluegrass Jackpot Show and will be subject to immediate disqualification.
5. Any individual ages Kindergarten to under 21 are eligible to show
6. Jackpot classes will be divided according to weight.
7. Official weigh in will be conducted upon registration.
8. There will be three (3) weight class divisions:
 - a. Light weight
 - b. Medium
 - c. Heavy
9. Any wether showing evidence of testicular tissue will be ineligible to show.
10. There is no limit on the number of animals youth can enter/exhibit.
11. Entries will be accepted until the close of the scales.
12. No refunds for no-shows.
13. There are no weight limits.
14. Classes will be divided as evenly as possible at the discretion of the show management.
15. Bedding will be provided. (Included in pen fees) All animals must be penned. Pens are 5X5 And cost \$15 per pen (all weekend) No straw or outside bedding.
16. Animals showing signs of contagious, or infectious disease, or external parasites will not be allowed in the barn or show.
17. Exhibitors must have all necessary health papers. Out of State entries must present a health certificate on each animal current within 30 days. All Health Certificates will be checked upon unloading animals. The certificate must be in accordance with The State of Kentucky regulation for state of origination. Kentucky animals to be exhibited must be accompanied by a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection signed by an accredited veterinarian within the year.
18. Use only grooming products that are allowed for meat producing animals when fitting animals for show.
