Wether Rules September 3 ,2010

Wether Classes are for exhibitors 21 yrs of age and younger. Classes will be determined by weight the day of the show. All wethers must be clean castrated males and must have all their milk teeth in place. Wethers with missing teeth or permanent adult teeth coming in will be disqualified. (No refunds given).

All wethers will be weighed the day of the show (between 5:30p.m.-6:00p.m.only) and divided into weight classes (no more than 15 in a class).Entry fees for the wethers will be \$5.00 per head. All out of state wethers must meet Kentucky State regulations and meet the new scrapie rules.

Payout: \$50. Grand Wether / \$25.Reserve Wether

Show Rules for September 3, 2010

- The Open breeding show will be sanctioned by International Boer Goat Association (IBGA) and their rules shall govern. In case of discrepancy or for rules not adequately covered, the show committee's decision and/or judge decision is final.
- Original registration certificates are required, though a copy of a Registration Application, stamped with the date received by one of the listed associations, can be accepted for kids less than 3 months of age.
- All animals must be in place, and registration papers checked in with the show secretary, by 6 p.m. the day of the show.
- No dogs, No alcoholic beverages, and No smoking allowed in the barns and show arena.
- No visible signs of abscesses or other contagious diseases (pinkeye, sore mouth, ringworm, ect.)will be allowed. ALL ANIMALS MUST BE HEALTHY. All goats must comply with Kentucky Scapie Rules
- All goats are required to have licensed veterinarian signed general health papers.
- To enter the state of Kentucky, out of state goats must follow Kentucky's Health guidelines. Any unhealthy or questionable animals checked by the veterinarian will be at the owners expense. Any animal of questionable health may be excused.
- Kentucky Classic/Bluegrass Goat Association will not be held responsible for loss or damages or accidents. Any person or family not acting in an honorable manner will be required to leave immediately and will not be allowed to return for the remainder of the show.
- Arrive on 9/3/10 **check in 2pm-6pm IBGA Show ONLY**

Entry Fees

- Entry fees for the open Boer breeding classes are \$10.00 per head each show Postmarked on/before August 31, 2010
- Entry fees postmarked after August 31, 2010 are \$15.00 per head each show
- Wether fees are \$5.00 each up to date of show
- Pen fees are \$5.00 each (2 head max. per pen)
- There will be a \$25.00 service charge on all NSF checks.
