**KINDRED SPIRITS CLASSIC**  
**Junior Market Goat Show**  
**October 2, 2010 9:00 a.m.**

1. ELIGIBILITY: Entries are open to youth 18 or under (pre-K to 12<sup>th</sup> grade). Animals entered in the Market Meat Goat Show are not eligible to show in the Breeding Boer Goat Show.
2. This show is open to any breed or crossbred wether or market doe.
3. Goats will be weighed by show officials on Friday October 1, from 5 p.m. to 9 p.m. Goats will then be divided into weight classes as equal in number as possible. (Number of classes may vary depending on the number of entries and the show officials' discretion.)
4. All goats must be carrying all milk teeth at time of weigh-in. Goats showing either or both of the first pair of permanent incisors will **not** be eligible to show.
5. **Bracing** of the goats **will not be permitted** for this show.
6. Entry Fee: \$10.00 per entry and \$5.00 per pen, includes first bedding.
7. All animals must have a current Health Certificate to show!

**SHOWMANSHIP**

1. Exhibitors from both the Market Meat Goat Show and Open Show are eligible to participate in the Showmanship classes.
2. Animals exhibited in showmanship must also be entered in either the Market Meat Goat weight classes or the Breeding Boer Goat classes for there to be NO FEE charged. If NOT entered in the Market Show or the Open show a fee of \$7.00 will be charged per entry.
3. Classes will be set after all entries are in. Number of classes may vary depending on the number of entries and the show officials' discretion.

# BREEDING BOER GOAT SHOW

Boer Goats must be checked-in with Superintendent at the barn by Friday, October 1, 2010, 9:00 p.m.

---

1. **Entries:** There is no limit to the number of animals an exhibitor may enter in the Breeding Boer Goat Show. All entries must be postmarked by September 28, 2010, and the entry fee of \$15.00 per goat and \$5.00 per pen must accompany the entry form. No straw, sand or other material will be allowed in the barn.  
LATE ENTRIES will be \$20.00 per entry if registering at check-in. However, substitutions will be allowed at no charge.
2. **Registration:** All goats six months or older must be registered with the International Boer Goat Association, American Boer Goat Association, Canadian Boer Goat Association, or United States Boer Goat Association. Original registration papers must be shown to the superintendent at check-in. Animals under six months of age must have a stamped duplicate or faxed duplicate application showing date received by the International BGA, ABGA, CBGA, or USBGA offices.
3. **Classes:** Animals will be shown by the age according to the registration certificate. Management reserves the right to combine or split classes.
4. **Identification:** All goats must have ID (ie: ear tag, tattoo), and this ID must match the registration papers of said goat at the time of check-in and ID must be included on the entry form.
5. All Intl. Boer Goat Association sanctioned show rules will be upheld and a copy will be available at show.
6. All judges decisions will be considered final.
7. Current health certificates are required!!
