Section I. Personal Information.

- **Ownership name to be listed on registration certificate: Place only the name or names that you want printed on certificate**
- **Person Registering Animal:** This should be the same as the person completing the application.
- **Mailing Address:** The Registration Certificate will be mailed to the address provided in these fields.

Section II. Animal Information

- **Country of Origin.** Country where conception took place. (Ex: Dam was bred in South Africa and the embryo was imported and born in the United States. Country of Origin would be South Africa.)
- **Country of Residence.** Determined by the location of the animal at the time the application is submitted to International Boer Goat Assn.
- **Sex.** Sex of animal to be registered. Male = Buck Female = Doe.
- **Birth Date.** The specific date the animal to be registered was born.
- **Percentage Boer.** Circle the percentage that best describes the animal to be registered. Certificate will reflect accurate percentage (see Rules for Registration).
- **Sire's ID.** Please provide the International Boer Goat Assn. registration number or a recognized association's registration number (see Rules for Registration for recognized associations) If the person registering the animal is not the owner of the sire at time of conception (or using A.I. breeding), then a Service Memo must also be submitted. (All offspring registered must be from a registered Boer Buck)
- **Dam's ID.** Please provide the International Boer Goat Assn. registration number or a recognized association's registration number (see Rules for Registration for recognized associations)
- **Tattoos.** The right ear tattoo should reflect the breeder's herd prefix; however, if an animal has been purchased without tattoos, the buyer may then use his herd prefix in the right ear. The left ear tattoo should begin with the letter code that reflects the year the animal was born (Ex: 2011 = A, 2012 = B, 2013 = C) followed by a number sequence (Ex: A01, A100, A1011. Do not use more than five characters in each ear. (See Rules for Registration)
- **Microchip Number.** Optional if the animal is tattooed in both ears. A microchip may take the place of tattoos provided a form of external identification is indicated (see Rules for Registration).
- **Horned, Polled or Disbudded.** An animal is considered Horned if it was born with horns and the horns have never been removed. An animal is considered Polled if it is born without the capability of producing horns. If the horns have been removed from an animal, then it has been disbudded.
- **Type of Breeding, Natural, ET (embryo transfer), or AI (artificial insemination).** The breeding is considered natural if the donor of the embryo gave birth to the animal being registered. If the embryos were removed from the donor and placed in a recipient doe the breeding is considered an embryo transfer and the recipient's number must be indicated. If semen is collected and then used to impregnate a doe, this breeding is considered artificial insemination. All flush records, straw codes, Service memos etc. must be included with registration application.
- **Birth Weight.** (actual weight at birth – optional)
- **Birth Rank.** Number of kids born in litter that animal to be registered is from.
- **Name of Animal to be Registered.** Please consider including your herd prefix or your farm/ranch name at the beginning (limit 30 characters). If preference is not indicated, a name will be assigned. (See Rules for Registration.)
- **Color Description.** (See Rules for Registration.) Animal must be registered in Non-Traditional Herd book to be eligible to show in non-traditional shows. (Check appropriate box)

Section III. Breeder Information

- **Breeder.** The breeder is described as the owner of the dam at the time of conception.

Section IV. Transfer of Animal to be registered.

- **Buyer's Information.** Please provide current information.
- **Date of Sale.** Required.
- **Seller's Signature.** Required if transfer is to be recognized.
